**Federal Poverty Level  
Food Stamp Eligibility**

**To determine your eligibility for food assistance programs:** Locate your family size in the far left column; moving to your right, locate a number in the food program column in which you are interested. You are "eligible to apply" to the program if your gross monthly income is less than the eligibility number.

**RESOURCE CONTACT INFORMATION**

**Department of Workforce Services (DWS):**

Applications for **Food Stamps** and other programs such as **FEP** (financial assistance for families); **Medicaid; Working Toward Employment;; Child Care; General Assistance; Workforce Investment Act; Unemployment Benefits; CHIP** and **Employment Center** is located at: 305 No. Main Street, Tooele UT. Call #833-7310 locally or statewide call toll-free 1-800-331-4341.

**Food Stamps Fast** – if you have less than \$150 income for the month you apply, and your cash on hand is less than \$100, OR if your shelter costs exceed your monthly income, you should ask for **“EXPEDITED SERVICE”** which means you may be eligible to receive Food Stamps within 7 days.

**WIC (Women, Infants & Children  
Supplemental Food Program)**

The WIC program provides supplemental food such as **Milk, Infant Formula, Eggs, Cheese, Juices, Cereals, and Beans** to pregnant women, nursing mothers, infants and children under the age of 5, who are low income (see Chart B to the left) and at nutritional risk. **CHIP (Children’s Health Ins. Program)**

CHIP provides working families up to 200% of the Federal Poverty Level, with affordable health insurance for their children. Toll-free 1-888-222-2542.

**Child & Adult Care Food Program (CACFP)**

Reimburses day care providers for food served to children in their care. Speak with your day care provider or call the State Child Nutrition Office at (801) 538-7680 for local contacts.

**School Lunch & Breakfast Programs**

The School Lunch Program is served in almost all Utah schools. Breakfast is served in some locations. Students from low-income families may receive free or reduced-price school meals (see income Charts A & B). Contact your school district at any time during the school year to apply.



**Senior Congregate Meals & Meals on Wheels**

Anyone age 60 or older, or the spouse of anyone age 60 or older, is eligible to participate in meals at Senior Congregate Meal sites. For each meal there is a suggested donation, generally \$2.00 or \$2.25. However, donations are not required to receive meals. Participants are encouraged to call ahead to make a reservation.
