To determine your eligibility for food assistance programs: Find your family size in the most-left column, then follow right to your desired program. If your gross *monthly income* is less than the amount indicated, you are eligible to apply.

School Lunch & Breakfast Programs

Expedited Food Stamps

Food Stamps Fast – if you have less than \$150 income for the month you apply, and your cash on hand is less than \$100, OR if your shelter costs exceed your monthly income, you should ask about expedited food stamps which means you may be eligible to receive Food Stamps within 7 days.

Apply Monday-Thursday 7:00 am to 6:00 pm

WIC (Women, Infants & Children Supplemental Food Program)

The WIC program provides supplemental food such as **Milk, Infant Formula, Eggs, Juices, Cereals, Beans, Fruits and Vegetables** to pregnant women, nursing mothers, infants and children under the age of 5, who are low income and at nutritional risk. (see Chart B opposite column on this page)
